



## Jeff Post

### President & Chief Executive Officer

Jeff Post is the President and Chief Executive Officer of CUNA Mutual Group based in Madison, Wisconsin. He heads the company that is the leading provider of insurance and financial services to credit unions and their members worldwide. As of December 31, 2006, CUNA Mutual had annual revenues of more than \$2.85 billion, assets exceeding \$15 billion, and a global workforce of 5,500 employees.

Under Jeff's direction, CUNA Mutual embarked on a three-year transformation plan in late 2005 aimed at positioning CUNA Mutual for success in its credit union marketplace. The plan included reinvention of the organization's sales distribution model, its customer service, and its product and investment strategies. In 2006, the first year of the plan, CUNA Mutual realized remarkable results, including record revenues, a 36% increase in profit, and a \$42 million increase in net investment income over the previous year. The company also began construction on a \$12 million Customer Operations Center in Fort Worth, Texas.

Prior to joining CUNA Mutual in January 2005, Jeff was President and Chief Executive Officer of Fireman's Fund, a position he held for more than three years before resigning in 2004. As CEO, he led an impressive financial turnaround for the company, improving underwriting results by more than \$1 billion and repositioning the company to market leadership in five business segments. In his 10 years with Fireman's Fund, Post also served as the Chief Financial Officer and Chief Actuary.

For its 2004 fiscal year, Fireman's Fund had \$10 billion in assets, \$5 billion in annual gross premiums and employed 4,800 people. It is part of the Allianz group, a worldwide leader in financial services headquartered in Munich, Germany. In addition to his role as President and Chief Executive Officer of Fireman's Fund, Jeff served on the parent company's International Executive Committee.

A native of Omaha, Nebraska, Jeff grew up in the Midwest and received a Bachelor's Degree in business administration, majoring in actuarial science, from the University of Wisconsin in 1981. He has more than 20 years of insurance industry experience. He is a fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society and a member of the American Academy of Actuaries.
